- 1 Yes I have studied these standards. No, I do not fully support them.
- 3 While I do think that school grading systems in the State of Florida are not reflective of the actual educational attainment of Florida students (or lack thereof), these grading systems are calculated by the Florida Department of Education's formulas, and not by local school boards. That being said, it is completely unacceptable that Collier County has been an A-rated district for several years running despite approximately 40% of our third-grade students not being able to read at grade level. The calculations that the State of Florida uses do not align with true student achievement and success.
- 6 No. I do not support any expansion of government involvement in education.
- 10 No I do not think CCPS student enrollment will decrease by a full 50%. But I hope to see a large percentage of parents becoming aware of this legislation and taking advantage of it to educate their children in the manner that is best for their futures. I am thankful to our governor and legislature for taking the lead on this important piece of legislation!
- 11 In the past I have answered this question as a "no". However, since that time, I have reviewed this issue further and feel that this may allow for retention of excellent staff while, at the same time, allowing for the high standards that we want for our students and taxpayers.
